

# Eligibility

The content must be pertaining to or of direct relevance to the practice of CME-CPD/IME. The content need not be Europe-specific but it would be helpful if lessons can be applied in the European/global sphere. The contribution must not promote a company, product or service, or be promotional in nature.

The presenter must be the primary author of the abstract and a registered delegate for the 17th Annual European CME Forum (#17ECF).

## **Oral presentation**

Should it fit with the meeting agenda, there may be the additional opportunity to present the poster as an oral presentation. In this case, the presentation should be delivered by the primary author, address a relevant topic within the identified session and be no longer than eight minutes when given.

## Publication in Journal of CME (JCME)

There will be a focus on publishing in CME, where poster content that is also intended for publication will have a higher chance of acceptance. Please indicate in your application whether you plan to develop the poster for submission to  $\mathcal{J}CME$ .

### Process

Applications must be submitted by **Monday 16 September 2024**. The entries will be reviewed by the session chairs under the chairmanship of the editor-in-chief of  $\mathcal{J}CME$ . Applicants will be notified of the outcome by email on **Monday 23 September 2024**.

Upon acceptance, poster authors will be required to send a PDF file of their poster and a brief video ( $\sim 2$  min) describing the poster.

Authors of accepted posters will be eligible for the #17ECF Early Bird rate at any time up until the meeting.

Subject to meeting the journal requirements, contributions will be invited for publication in *JCME*.
