Workshop Call for Proposals

Eligibility

The content must be pertaining to, or of relevance to, the practice of CME-CPD/IME. It can draw on experiences in undergraduate and graduate education, outside the medical field, or be examples from countries outside of Europe, as long as it is applicable to the European and global CME-CPD sphere.

The session and related materials must not promote a company, product or service, or be promotional in nature. Session leaders must be registered participants of the 18th Annual European CME Forum (#18ECF).

Wednesday and Thursday workshops

This year we are seeking proposals to run a 45 minute workshop on Wednesday and/or Thursday at 18ECF. Workshops must contribute to one of the meeting categories listed below. The workshop should be interactive and educational in nature and be structured to engage participants in identifying challenges and solutions within a defined theme or concept. Note that both the Wednesday and Thursday workshops will each be repeated once or continued if there is a 'Part 1' and 'Part 2' structure. This is to enable participants to benefit from multiple sessions.

We may ask you to adapt your proposal slightly to fit in with other sessions or themes. We aim to collate related sessions in order to have a cohesive overall meeting structure.

Value of CME-CPD as a system (Wednesday workshop)

Looking at the value of CME-CPD from a system-wide perspective e.g. a regulatory, engagement or compliance valuation, etc.

Value of CME to the learner (Thursday workshop)

A topic focusing on or demonstrating how CME-CPD is of value to learners, e.g. maintaining and enhancing competence, improving professional performance and patient outcomes, addressing real-world challenges, promoting professional growth and career advancement, etc. *Priority will be given to submissions that includes a "learner" in the planning and delivery of your workshop!* If you would like to work collaboratively with a local Manchester-based HCP, let us know what type of doctor/allied health professional you are looking for and we will find one for you!

Deliverables

Introductory video (before the meeting): video (1-2 min) outlining the objectives of the session

Pre-reading: it is encouraged to provide some pre-meeting materials to help prepare the participants

Elevator pitch (delivered live during the meeting): to deliver a pitch (1–2 min) to the plenary room outlining the session

Workshop: Wednesday and Thursday workshops to be presented twice as part of several concurrent sessions (see notes above; 2 x 45 min)

Reflection session: planning the contribution to a panel discussion reviewing key outcomes from the workshop (this will be shorter than in previous meetings, led by a member of the session, not the leader)

Process

Proposals to be submitted by **Monday 21 July 2025**. The entries will be reviewed by the session chairs. Participants will be notified of the outcome by email on **Monday 28 July 2025**.
