# Call for Abstracts Guidance

# To run a Workshop

### **Eligibility**

The scope of the Workshop must contribute to the theme "Reevaluating European and global CME-CPD" and fall under one of the subcategories:

#### Innovation and impact

Including, but not limited to, accreditation, regulation, self-certification, legal obligations, ethical considerations, national requirements, curriculum development, personal development, healthcare systems, employer responsibility, patient interactions, insurance requirements, etc.

#### Attitude and culture

Including interprofessional continuing education, voice of the patient, outcomes analysis, needs assessment, gap analysis, digitisation of continuing education, team-based approaches, use of technology, learning modalities, educational effectiveness, etc.

#### **Environment and community**

Any topic related to the funding of medical education and/or its independence

The content must be pertaining to, or of relevance to, the practice of IME/CME-CPD, it can draw on experiences in undergraduate and graduate education, or national examples in countries outside of Europe, as long as it is be applicable to the European and global CME-CPD sphere.

#### **Deliverables**

**Elevator pitch** — a 60-120 second video outlining the objectives of the session

**Pre-reading** — it is encouraged to provide some pre-meeting materials to help guide the participants

**Workshop** — 90 minutes, to be presented as one of 4 concurrent workshops

**Reflection** — a 20 minute report from the session to the plenary room for further engagement and Q&A

The workshop itself should be interactive and educational in nature, structured to engage participants to identify challenges, reach an agreement, or other outcome which summarises the group opinion of a defined theme or concept.

The workshop and related materials must not promote a company, product or service, or be promotional in nature. Workshop leaders must be registered on-site participants of the 15th Annual European CME Forum.

#### **Process**

Submissions to be submitted by **Monday 19 September 2022**. The entries will be reviewed by the Session Chairs. Participants will be notified of the outcome by email on **Monday 26 September 2022**.
