Call for Abstracts

Poster presentation guidance

Eligibility

The content must pertain to, or be relevant to, the practice of CME/CPD/Independent Medical Education (IME). Proposals may draw on experiences in undergraduate or postgraduate education, from outside the medical field, or from countries outside Europe, provided the learning is applicable to the European and global CME/CPD environment.

Posters must not promote a company, product, or service. The poster presenter must be the primary author and a registered participant of the 19th Annual European CME Forum (#19ECF).

Oral presentation

Should it fit with the meeting agenda, there may be the additional opportunity to present the poster as an oral presentation. In this case, the presentation should be delivered by the primary author, address a relevant topic within the identified session and be no longer than eight minutes when given.

Publication in *Journal of CME (JCME)*

There will be a focus on publishing in CME, where poster content that is also intended for publication will have a higher chance of acceptance. Please indicate in your application whether you plan to develop the poster for submission to *JCME*.

Process

Applications must be submitted by **Monday 28 September 2026**. The entries will be reviewed by the session chairs under the chairmanship of the editor-in-chief of *JCME*. Applicants will be notified of the outcome by email on **Monday 12 October 2026**.

Upon acceptance, poster authors will be required to send a PDF file of their poster and a brief video (~2 min) describing the poster.

Authors of accepted posters will be eligible for the #19ECF Early Bird rate at any time up until the meeting.

Subject to meeting the journal requirements, contributions will be invited for publication in *JCME*.
